Mission

The ETC Cooperative is committed to supporting community, development, and marketing efforts within the Ethereum Classic ecosystem. Our goal is simply to make ETC better by removing pain points and obstacles that interfere with ETC's current and future users. We aim to help anywhere (i) tools are not up to snuff, (ii) information is lacking, or (iii) awareness of ETC's value is not known.

Many aspects of the ETC Cooperative's operations have significant overlap; for example, improvements to development are often improvements for the community. To better present our efforts over the past 6 months we have divided them into:

- “Technical Enhancements” – Providing the end-user tools and technical information that is necessary to use ETC.
- “Community Building” – Providing the information and resources that community members expect.
- “Outreach” – Reaching out to other cryptocurrency communities to expand ETC's reach.

Accomplishments

To better serve the community, we are releasing biannual reviews of our efforts every 6 months. This document represents the first such review and covers the period of January to June 2018.

These past 6 months have seen massive inflow of interest into Ethereum Classic, and substantial growth of the ETC community.

- Our subreddit ([/r/ethereumclassic](https://www.reddit.com/r/ethereumclassic)) has grown from 12,000 to 20,500 subscribers (+70%)
- The largest ETC Twitter account ([@eth_classic](https://twitter.com/eth_classic)) has rocketed from 125,000 to 200,000 followers (+60%)
- Average transactions more than doubled from 17,000 to 47,000 per day (+175%)

However, many portions of ETC went undermaintained. For example:

- Only one reliable block explorer existed
- Coordinating upgrades with miners and exchanges was difficult
- The main ETC website (ethereumclassic.org) was outdated
- The international community was underserved
- ETC was largely seen as separate to the broader Ethereum community.

The ETC Cooperative identified these and many other pain points for ETC adoption and has made substantial progress in correcting these issues.

Technical Enhancements

On-Going

Etherhub.io Improvements \$6,000

ETC had the first opensource Ethereum-based block explorer. However the project needed substantial upgrades.

[Etherhub.io](#), and the [underlying software](#), now work smoothly with more feature improvements planned.

On-Going

Software Integration of ETC \$15,000

Support for ETC's blockchain can be improved to give ETC both better representation and easier use in the broader cryptocurrency ecosystem.

ETC Cooperative is working with Ethereum, Metamask, and Parity on various efforts:

- PeaceRelay* – Cross-chain tx's with ETH
- Metamask – Proposal to support ETC
- Parity – Potential auto-updating

*PeaceRelay was initially developed by KyberNetwork but requires further work to make it suitable for regular use.

Improved Bootnodes \$1,000

When someone uses software to connect to the ETC network they first connect to computers / servers called bootnodes.

ETC Cooperative now provides servers to allow for faster and more reliable connections to the ETC network.

Upgrade Notifications \$3,000 ◇

It is manual and time consuming to ensure all stakeholders (miners, exchanges, and service providers) are upgraded in time for network upgrades.

ETC Cooperative developed a mailing list and worked alongside ETCDEV to ensure these stakeholders were upgraded in time for hard forks and a recently discovered security issue.

In Progress – Q3

Technical Guide \$5,000

ETC needs adequate technical documentation for advanced users, programmers, and system administrators to be able to make effective use of ETC. This technical guide will help fill this need.

Community Building

On-Going

Community Support \$5,000 ◇

Various chat channels need moderation to function effectively. Moderation combats spam and maintains an orderly and welcoming environment.

The ETC Coop, IOHK, and very dedicated volunteers provide this service for the community.

EthereumClassic.org \$30,000

For 2 years EthereumClassic.org went under-maintained.

This update clearly communicates ETC's message for both current and future ETC users. The website provides information, a cross-team roadmap, and well curated resources to connect new users to the broader ETC community.

EthereumClassicAsia.org \$30,000

Prior to launch the ETC community in China, Japan, and South Korea did not have a reliable source of information on ETC in their native language.

EthereumClassicAsia.org makes ETC much more accessible to these countries and serves as the Asia-based equivalent of EthereumClassic.org.

In Progress – Q3

ETC Summit 2018 \$140,000

This event will both increase awareness of ETC and bring together interested parties of a broad range of industries, enabling them to collectively discover ETC's benefits and enhance cooperation. Ultimately resulting in real-world ETC applications and solutions.

The ETC Cooperative is organizing the event, recruiting speakers, sponsors, and performing various campaigns to raise awareness of the event along with local partners in South Korea.

ETC Cooperative is actively sponsoring other conferences to increase their attendee's exposure to, and knowledge of ETC. Currently sponsoring DOGECon and Consensus Singapore.

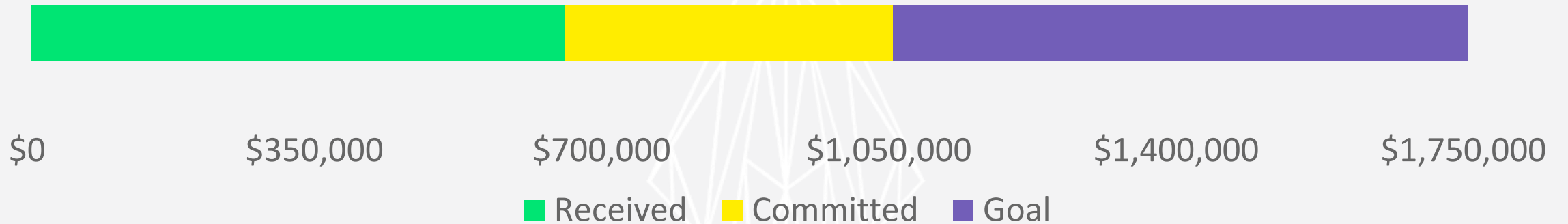


Donate
